Blood glucose measurement without taking blood: Solianis Monitoring AG: New clinical results look optimistic

Zürich, April 11th 2007: Solianis Monitoring AG has taken another important step in the development of a non-invasive system to determine blood glucose. In the latest part of the clinical trials at the University Hospital in Zürich, the sensors have been tested under conditions approaching daily life step-by-step, i.e. normal eating, drinking and moderate movements. It is the opinion of experts that the multi-sensor platform developed by Solianis managed these more difficult conditions well.

According to Marc Donath, Professor for Endocrinology und Diabetology at the University Hospital in Zürich, the results are promising and the development can be moved forward as planned. "It has been shown that the clinical trials performed by Solianis provide another important cornerstone in the concept of non-invasive glucose monitoring. From a clinical perspective, the possibilities offered by this technology complement the traditional methods very well.
